Located in the Kippenberger Pavilion (KP) of the National Army Museum Te Mata Toa, the Kippenberger Research Centre is one of the leading military research centres in New Zealand. The Research Centre library houses a military collection of over 15,000 titles on all aspects of military history that includes books, brochures, newspapers, articles, and online databases.

Any historical study of significance to New Zealanders can be supported here, with high schools throughout New Zealand visiting to utilise the military collection for their students conducting study for NCEA history. The topics that are consistently requested for students are:

- The New Zealand Wars
- World War I
- World War II
- 28th Māori Battalion
- Vietnam War
- Women in War
- The Home Front

Our Research Centre staff are able to assist with accessing resources relevant to the students' topics and have them available prior to the students' arrival, and are on-hand to assist the teachers and students throughout their study time in the Research Centre. In addition to the library space, a private research room is available to book, providing a space for students to spread out and study. Our Education Team can also guide students through the Museum to galleries and displays that support their research topic.
